

Thoughts from our Pastor

Someone has said, "Christmas is more than a holiday; it is a declaration of hope." At Northgate, one of the ways we celebrate season of this hope is with the Advent wreath. In this wreath, we place five candles, each one proclaiming a different perspective of Advent. The word "Advent," comes from the Latin word, *adventus*, meaning "arrival" or



"coming." Three of the five candles are purple, one is pink and one is white. The purple candles (weeks one, two and four) represent faith, hope and peace. The pink candle (week three) represents joy. As each candle is lit on its respective Sunday, we are reminded of a different focus on the coming of Christmas. The white candle that is lit on Christmas Eve is known to us simply as the "Christ candle." But it represents the justice, light and victory that we have through the gift of Jesus Christ.

We have faith, hope, joy and peace because we have Christ. Christmas is so much more than just a holiday. It is the declaration of hope.

As we go through this season of reflection upon the enormous gift of Christ, I invite you to join me in remembering what Jesus said in John 8:12 – "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."
